



Lancombe Country Cottages, Maiden Newton, Dorset.



Background

Lancombe Country Cottages are set amongst the finest scenery in Dorset in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The site holds six cottages, a swimming pool, sauna and laundry, so water demand frequently used to exceed the capacity of the original shallow borehole and pumps. The remote rural location rules out the possibility of a mains supply, so Pipefix were commissioned to specify, design and install a new borehole to supplement the existing supply.

Specified Solution

- 97m deep borehole sunk through clay and sand
- Shaft lined with Stainless Steel
- Innovative easy maintenance pump fitted
- Booster pumps upgraded and replaced
- Pipework upgraded and replaced
- 2x 6000ltr GRP water storage tanks installed
- Automatic Pumps, cut off and overload switches installed
- Filters upgraded
